If physician does not accept offer, a notice of contemplated action will be issued based on, but not limited to, interaction with patients that adversely affects patient care, conduct likely to harm, failure to report adverse action, and conduct unbecoming. If physician does not accept offer, a notice of contemplated action will be issued based on, but not limited to, interaction with patients and others that could adversely affect patient care, conduct unbecoming and conduct likely to
