Including Test to treat uncomplicated UTI protocol (official title is Pharmacist Prescribing Dangerous Drugs in Conjunction with POCT in uUTI).

As of May 1, 2024 total expenditures on the Licensing Database project is \$1,537,252 (or 84.8% of the appropriated funds) and \$49,006 (or 2.7%) is currently committed through an encumbrance for Operations and Maintenance and Enhancements with Kyra Solutions. The appropriation end date is June 30, 2024. The balance remaining in the appropriation is \$224,940.

Mr. Romero spoke briefly about his role of representing the Board in the legislature, the Senate Budget procedures, legislative updates and educating legislators on the function of the Board.

15. Health Policy Advisor, Officer of the Governor – Gina DeBlassie

Ms. DeBlassie spoke briefly regarding the efforts of the Governors officer to support the NMMB. She suggested that the Board should educate the large medical organizations about the NMMB application process and licensing statistics. Ms. DiBlassie also stated that it would be beneficial to the Board do some public relations work to educate the public, legislature and large medical organizations, etc. on the functions of the NMMB, licensing statistics and efforts to expedite licensure while continuing to protect the public. Ms. DiBlassie stated that she agrees that the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact would benefit the state with regard to quick licensing and will work with us to try and get a Bill passed to enact the Compact.
